

Women's Cricket Leagues Survey 2026: PRIZE DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Prize Draw Overview

1. The England and Wales Cricket Board Limited (company number 03251364) whose registered office is at Lords Cricket Ground, St Johns Wood, London, NW8 8QZ (the "ECB") is operating a prize draw for individuals who have participated in the Women's Cricket Leagues Survey 2026 and opted in to receive marketing communications from the ECB to be in with a chance of winning two tickets to the T20i - ICC Women's T20 World Cup, 2026 - 1st Semi-Final at The Oval, London (the "Prize Draw").
2. Individuals entering the Prize Draw (the "Entrants") are deemed to have accepted, and agreed to be bound by, these terms and conditions upon entry in to Prize Draw.

Entry Process

3. The Prize Draw will be open for entry between [12:00] on [24/02/2026] (the "Opening Date") and [12:00] on [31/03/2026] (the "Closing Date"). Any entry completed or received outside of this period (i.e. before the Opening Date or after the Closing Date) and/or other than in accordance with the entry requirements set out below will not be considered.
4. To enter the Prize Draw, Entrants must answer the questions accessed via the Women's Cricket Leagues Survey. Entries to the Prize Draw will not be accepted by any other means.
5. The Prize Draw is free to enter. No purchase is necessary.

Eligibility

6. The Prize Draw is open to all in who successfully complete the survey and tick the box to confirm that they wish to be entered into the Prize Draw and who are aged 16 or over and resident within the United Kingdom. Employees of the ECB are not eligible to enter the Prize Draw. Any Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the written consent of their parent and/or carer to enter any Prize Draw and to claim any Prize (as defined below). Employees of the ECB are not eligible to enter any of the Prize Draws.
7. By entering the Prize Draw, Entrants confirm that they are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize they may win.
8. There is a limit of one entry to the Prize Draw per person.
9. The ECB reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe that the Entrant has breached these terms and conditions.

Prize

10. There will be one winner of the Prize Draw (the "Winner") and the prize for the Winner is two tickets to the T20i - ICC Women's T20 World Cup, 2026 - 1st Semi-Final at The Oval, London.
11. The Winner will be drawn at random via a computer-generated selection process on, or soon after, the Closing Date.
12. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The prize does not include anything not expressly set out in these terms and conditions. The prize is subject to availability and the ECB reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute the Winner's prize for an alternative prize, if necessary.
13. The prize is awarded at the ECB's discretion and no prize will be awarded as a result of improper actions on or behalf of any Entrant.

Claiming the Prize

14. The selection of the Winner at random on the date specified above will be final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into regarding the outcome of the Prize Draw.
15. The ECB will contact the Winner as soon as reasonably practicable after selection, using the email address provided upon entry to the Prize Draw as detailed in clause 4 above.
16. The Winner must claim their prize, by responding to the ECB, within 48 hours of being notified by the ECB via email that they have won the prize. Only the Winner will be notified.
17. Upon claiming their prize, the Winner will be required to provide an email address for receiving delivery of the relevant prize. The Winner's prize will be sent to the Winner by email within 30 days of being notified of their win.
18. The ECB reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to offer the prize to another Entrant where a Winner:

- a. fails to claim their prize (including failure to provide an email address for delivery) within the prescribed timeframe;
 - b. fails to meet the eligibility requirements set out in these terms and conditions;
 - c. is unable or does not want to accept the Prize that they have won for any reason.
19. The ECB does not accept any responsibility for failure by a Winner to claim their prize.

Limitation of Liability

20. Neither the ECB nor any of its partners, affiliates, agents, employees, officers, directors or representatives will be liable (to the fullest extent permitted by law) for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage arising out of the organising or holding of the Prize Draw or as a result of any Entrant's participation in the Prize Draw or as a result of winning, collecting, use or enjoyment of the prize, if the Prize Draw does not run as planned or if the prize (or any part of the prize) is unable to be delivered for any reason. Entrants' statutory rights are not affected.
21. If the Prize Draw, or any part of it, is not capable of running or being completed as planned for any reason, including but not limited to reasons of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the ECB, the ECB reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Prize Draw without liability.
22. The ECB accepts no responsibility for Prize Draw entries that are not successfully completed or submitted, regardless of cause, including (without limitation) due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure, of any kind.

Entrants' Personal Data

23. Any personal data relating to any individual which is received by the ECB in relation to the Prize Draw will be used in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation and the ECB's Privacy Notice which can be found here.
24. The ECB must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation, details of the Winner (name and county) will be made available to anyone who emails [feedback@ecb.co.uk] within one month of the Closing Date. If an Entrant objects to any of their details being published or made available in accordance with this clause, please contact the ECB at [feedback@ecb.co.uk]. In such circumstances, the ECB must still provide the information to the Advertising Standards Authority, on request.
25. If an Entrant has any questions about these terms and conditions, including any request to exercise their legal rights under data protection law, they should contact the ECB at privacy@ecb.co.uk.

General

26. The ECB reserves the right to refuse entry to the Prize Draw, to disqualify an Entrant from the Prize Draw, or to refuse to award the Prize to anyone who it reasonably considers has breached these terms and conditions or to anyone, who in ECB's sole opinion, has otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
27. The ECB reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the Prize Draw where it becomes necessary to do so.
28. If any provision of these terms and conditions is found to be invalid by any court having competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of that provision will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of these terms and conditions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
29. These terms and conditions (and any non-contractual obligations or dispute arising out of or in connection with them) will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. All Entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales in relation to any dispute or claims arising out of, or in connection with, these terms and conditions or relating to the Prize Draw.
