

## WOMEN'S CRICKET LEAGUES SURVEY 2026: PRIZE DRAW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Prize Draw Overview

1. The England and Wales Cricket Board Limited (company number 03251364), whose registered office is at Lords Cricket Ground, St Johns Wood, London, NW8 8QZ (the “**ECB**”), is operating a prize draw for individuals to have the opportunity to win certain match tickets (as detailed under the section entitled ‘Prize’ below) (the “**Prize Draw**”).
2. Individuals entering the Prize Draw (the “**Entrants**”) are deemed to have accepted, and agree to be bound by, these terms and conditions upon entry into the Prize Draw.

### Entry Process

3. The Prize Draw will be open for entry between 17:00pm (GMT) on 23 February 2026 (the “**Opening Date**”) and 12:00pm (GMT) on 31 March 2026 (the “**Closing Date**”). Any entry completed or received after the Closing Date and/or other than in accordance with the entry requirements set out in these terms and conditions will be automatically disqualified from the Prize Draw.
4. To enter the Prize Draw, an individual will be able to enter via one of the five (5) routes set out below:
  - a. **Route 1 – Survey shared by the ECB over email on the “Cricket Collective Bulletin”**: individuals who are subscribed to receive marketing communications from the ECB will receive the “Cricket Collective Bulletin” via email on the Opening Date of the Prize Draw, which will contain a hyperlink to the “Women’s Cricket Leagues Survey 2026” (the “**Survey**”);
  - b. **Route 2 – Survey shared by the ECB over email on marketing communications**: between the Opening Date and Closing Date, individuals who are subscribed to receive marketing communications from the ECB will receive a hyperlink to the Survey via email communications;
  - c. **Route 3 – Survey made available across the ECB’s social media channels**: between the Opening Date and Closing Date, there will be a hyperlink to the Survey on advertising posts made available on the following official social media channels of the ECB: Instagram, LinkedIn and X;
  - d. **Route 4 – Survey made available to registered attendees of “The Metro Bank Girls in Cricket Fund Network Live 2026” event via QR code**: registered attendees of “The Metro Bank Girls in Cricket Fund Network Live 2026” event held on 7 and 8 March 2026 at the East Midlands Conference Centre at the University of Nottingham will have a chance to enter the Prize Draw by scanning a QR code made available at such event, which will provide a link to the Survey on compatible devices; or
  - e. **Route 5 – Survey made available on an article on the ECB website**: between the Opening Date and Closing Date, the ECB will post an article on its website at <http://www.ecb.co.uk/news>, which will contain a hyperlink to the Survey.

In respect of each route (as set out above), Entrants must complete and submit the Survey and tick the box to confirm they wish to be entered into the Prize Draw before the Closing Date. Entries to the Prize Draw will not be accepted by any other means other than the five (5) routes above.

5. The Prize Draw is free to enter. No purchase will be necessary to enter the Prize Draw.

### Eligibility

6. The Prize Draw is only open to residents in the United Kingdom aged 16 years or older at the time of entry to the Prize Draw but excluding employees of the ECB its associated companies and agencies, their immediate families or anyone else involved in the organisation or administration of the Prize Draw. Any Entrants under the age of 18 must obtain the written consent of their parent and/or carer to enter any Prize Draw and to claim the Prize (as defined below in clause 11).
7. Each individual Entrant may only enter or will only be entered into the Prize Draw once. If the same Entrant attempts to submit multiple entries or the ECB discovers that an Entrant has entered the Prize Draw on someone else’s behalf, then the ECB may, at its absolute sole discretion, limit such entries to a single entry only or disqualify that Entrant from the Prize Draw.
8. By entering the Prize Draw, each Entrant confirms that they are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the Prize (as defined below) that they may win. The ECB may require an Entrant to provide proof that they are eligible to enter the Prize Draw (including proof of age or residence).
9. The ECB reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe that the Entrant has breached these terms and conditions.

### Prize

10. There will be, in total, one (1) winner of the Prize Draw (the “**Winner**”).
11. The Winner will receive two (2) match tickets to the T20i - ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2026 (the first semi-final), scheduled to take place at 14:30pm (BST) on 30 June 2026 at The Oval, London (the “**Prize**”).
12. The Winner will be drawn at random via a computer-generated selection process on, or soon after, the Closing Date.
13. Only the Winner will be contacted as soon as reasonably practicable after the completion of the Prize Draw via email. The Winner must confirm that they are able to accept the Prize within 48 hours of being notified by the ECB that they are the Winner. If the Winner fails to confirm their acceptance of the Prize by this date or is unable to accept the Prize that they have won for any reason or the ECB determines that the Winner has breached these terms and conditions, the ECB reserves the right to offer the Prize to another Entrant. The ECB does not accept any responsibility for failure by the Winner to claim their Prize.
14. Each ticket Prize will be sent to the Winner by email no earlier than 30 days in advance of the scheduled date of the match for which the ticket Prize relates to. The Winner will not be liable for any costs related to shipping.
15. The Prize will be non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The Prize may also not be sold by the Winner or passed on to another individual in the case of tickets. The Prize does not include anything not expressly set out in these terms and conditions, including spending money, food and drink, associated travel and accommodation, medical or other general expenses. In the case of ticket Prizes, they shall also be subject to the applicable ticketing terms and conditions and any applicable ground rules at the venue where the fixture or experience is held, and the scheduled date, time and venue for a match may be subject to change, in which case the ECB shall notify the Winner as soon as reasonably practicable. If the Winner is unable to attend a fixture, they must notify the ECB at least 30 days prior to such fixture and must not transfer or sell any tickets for such fixture to another person. If relevant, the Winner will be responsible for ensuring that they and any person travelling with them are available to travel and hold valid passports, any necessary visas and travel documents on the relevant dates. The ECB shall not be responsible if the Winner is unable to take up the Prize for such reasons.
16. The Prize will always be subject to availability, and the ECB reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute the Prize for an alternative prize, if necessary.
17. The Winner may be contacted to participate in publicity related to the Prize Draw, but participation is optional. If the Winner agrees to participate in any such publicity activities, the Winner and their guest agree that the ECB may, with prior consent of the Winner and their guest, record, film and/or photograph their participation in all aspects of the relevant Prize and exploit, and authorise third parties to exploit, such films, photographs or recordings in any media now known or hereafter invented in any part of the world and for any purpose whatsoever in perpetuity, with no payment being due. The ECB will, in due time, provide the Winner with all relevant information regarding this specific processing of personal data and request consent from the Winner before implementing said processing.

#### **Limitation of Liability**

18. Neither the ECB nor any of its partners, affiliates, agents, employees, officers, directors or representatives will be liable (to the fullest extent permitted by law) for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage arising out of the organising or holding of the Prize Draw or as a result of any Entrant’s participation in the Prize Draw or as a result of winning, collecting, use or enjoyment of the Prize, if the Prize Draw does not run as planned or if the Prize (or any part of the Prize) is unable to be delivered for any reason. Entrants’ statutory rights are not affected.
19. If the Prize Draw, or any part of it, is not capable of running or being completed as planned for any reason, including but not limited to reasons of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the ECB, the ECB reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Prize Draw without liability.
20. The ECB accepts no responsibility for Prize Draw entries that are not successfully completed or submitted, regardless of cause, including (without limitation) due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure, of any kind.

#### **Entrants’ Personal Data**

21. Any personal data relating to any individual which is received by the ECB in relation to the Prize Draw will be used in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation and the ECB’s Privacy Notice which can be found at: <https://www.ecb.co.uk/about/privacy-policy>.
22. The ECB may be required to either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation, the ECB will send the surname and county of the Winner to anyone who emails [feedback@ecb.co.uk](mailto:feedback@ecb.co.uk) or sends a letter addressed to the ECB using the address given above, (enclosing a self-

addressed envelope) within one month of the Closing Date. If an Entrant objects to any or all of their surname and county being published or made available, please contact the ECB using the email address or postal address referred to in this clause. In such circumstances, the ECB must still provide the information to the Advertising Standards Authority, on request.

#### **General**

24. The ECB reserves the right to refuse entry to the Prize Draw, to disqualify an Entrant from the Prize Draw, or to refuse to award the Prize to anyone who it reasonably considers has breached these terms and conditions or to anyone, who in the ECB's sole opinion, has otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
25. The decision of the ECB regarding any aspect of the Prize Draw is final and binding (including as to the award of the Prize(s)) and no correspondence will be entered into regarding any such decision.
26. If any provision of these terms and conditions is found to be invalid by any court having competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of that provision will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of these terms and conditions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
27. These terms and conditions and any dispute or claim (including any non-contractual disputes or claims) arising out of or in connection with them will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. All Entrants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales in relation to any dispute or claims arising out of, or in connection with, these terms and conditions or relating to the Prize Draw.
